


'Rooted in Reading' - Principles

Your Passport- Years 3/4



-12 Journeys in total (including fiction, non-fiction, plays, reading on screen, books linked to tv & film, magazines, a books from other cultures, poetry)

-They can be done in any order!

-When you've completed a journey you will be given a stamp by your class teacher. You might even be asked to share your reading journey with the class!

-You can earn 4 bonus stamps for actual journeys to a library, book store, author signings. Again, you might be asked to share your experience!

-6 stamps and your name will be put on the 'Bronze' cup in reception and you will receive a 'Bronze' certificate.

-12 Stamps and your name will be put on the 'Silver' cup and you will receive a 'Silver' certificate.

-16 Stamps and your name will be put on the 'Gold' cup and you will receive a "Gold' certificate. You will also receive a 'Completion of Passport Badge' which will be awarded in celebration assembly.



Your Passport- Years 5/6



-28 Journeys in total (including fiction, non-fiction, plays, reading on screen, books linked to tv & film, magazines, a books from other cultures, poetry)

-They can be done in any order!

-When you've completed a journey you will be given a stamp by your class teacher. You might even be asked to share your reading journey with the class!


-You can earn 4 bonus stamps for actual journeys to a library, book store, author signings. Again, you might be asked to share your experience!

-12 stamps and your name will be put on the 'Bronze' cup in reception and you will receive a 'Bronze' certificate.

-24 Stamps and your name will be put on the 'Silver' cup and you will receive a 'Silver' certificate.

-28 Stamps and your name will be put on the 'Gold' cup and you will receive a "Gold' certificate. You will also receive a 'Completion of Passport Badge' which will be awarded in celebration assembly.


How?
