

COVID 19 related absence – Information for Parents / Carers and Staff

What to do if ...	Action needed:	Return to school when ...
... my child has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Please get a test as soon as possible • Inform school immediately of the test result • Contact school daily • Access online learning daily, if well enough 	... the test comes back negative and your child is feeling well.
..... my child tests positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Inform school immediately of the positive test result • Contact school daily • Self-isolate for at least 10 days • Access online learning daily, if well enough 	... child must self-isolate at home for at least 10 days and until their temperature has gone and they are feeling well.
...somebody in my household has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school daily • Self-isolate • Household member to get a test • Inform school of the test result • Access online learning daily 	...the household member test is negative. The child must get a test if symptoms develop.
...somebody in my household has tested positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school daily • Self-isolate for 14 days • Access online learning daily the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation. The child must get a test if symptoms develop.
...NHS test and trace have identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school daily • Self-isolate for 14 days • Access online learning daily 	... the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation. The child must get a test if symptoms develop.
... somebody in my child's class has tested positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Self-isolate for the period that Public Health advise • Access online learning daily • Contact school daily 	<p>... the child has completed the isolation period. The child must get a test if symptoms develop.</p> <p><i>Siblings in other class bubbles can still attend school if they are well, as they have not been in 'close contact' with someone with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus.</i></p>
We / my child has travelled and has to self-isolate / quarantine as per government advice	<p><u>Please avoid taking holidays abroad which may then result in requiring quarantine upon return.</u></p> <p>Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school daily • Self-isolate for 14 days • Access online learning daily 	... the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed. Any family must get a test if symptoms develop.
... we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school as required for support and to discuss the online curriculum and pastoral support • Shield until you are informed the restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused • Access online learning daily you are informed that shielding restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again.
